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Boundaries & Personal Space

What are boundaries?

Guidelines, rules or limits that a person creates to identify for him- or herself what are reasonable, safe and permissible ways for other people to behave around him or her and how he or she will respond when someone steps outside those limits.

In simpler terms - boundaries represent physical and emotional limits that you don't want other people to cross. They help define your sense of self by separating your needs, desires, thoughts, and feelings from those of others'.

Boundaries are the dividing lines between you and everyone else and they help make you an individual from the group.

Knowing that you don't like to talk about family problems at work is your boundary, even though your co-workers feel ok doing that.

What is personal space?

Personal space is the physical distance between one person and another.

Personal space is our "comfort zone". When it is breached, we often begin to feel uncomfortable.

It is a type of non-verbal communication that allows us to express without saying anything the intimacy of a relationship, express our emotions and let others know when we are uncomfortable.

Personal space can be considered a boundary with which one feels comfortable. However, these boundaries can be violated in specific situations, such as when confronting someone or if a person is unaware of the other's boundaries.
