In 1916 President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation that officially established June 14th as Flag Day. In August 1949 President Harry Truman signed the legislation and proclaimed June 14th as Flag Day.

Today people celebrate Flag Day with parades and displaying the flags on homes and businesses.

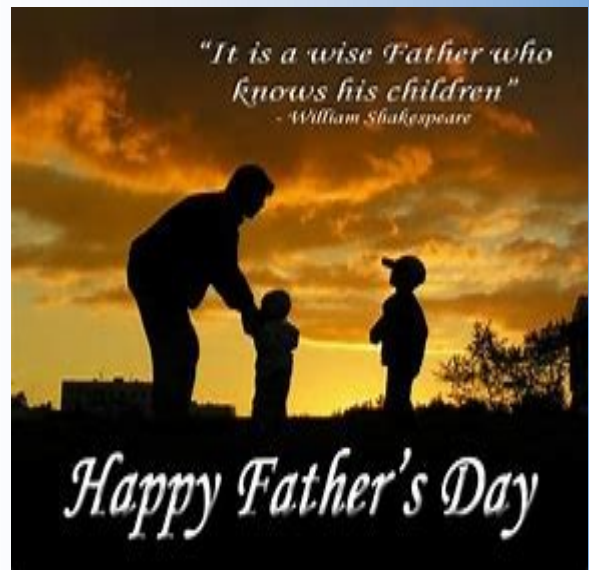
