National Cancer Survivors Day



National Cancer Survivors Day® is a poignant, inspiring Celebration of Life led by the National Cancer Survivors Day Foundation. It is also a call to action for further research, more resources, and increased public awareness to improve the lives of cancer survivors. This day provides an opportunity for all people living with a history of cancer – America has more than 18 million cancer survivors – to connect with each other, celebrate milestones, and recognize those who have supported them along the way. Many children who suffer from cancer must take medications that cause them to lose their hair and they often feel self-conscious about their situation and condition, and then their hair falls out. They may believe that they might have made fun of someone else if it had not happened to them, and so it may be that if anyone even looks at them to understand their problem, they feel persecuted. If you know a child going through something like this, reach out to them and let them know that you care.

World Elder Abuse Awareness Day.

The purpose of WEAAD is to raise awareness about the millions of older adults who experience elder abuse, neglect, and financial exploitation. As many as 1 in 10 older Americans are abused or neglected each year, yet only 1 in 14 cases of elder abuse ever come to authorities' attention². Elder abuse can be defined as “a single, or repeated act, or lack of appropriate action, occurring within any relationship where there is an expectation of trust which causes harm or distress to an older person” and is a global social issue affecting the health and human rights of millions of older persons worldwide. At Danger Aware we too are working to educate the elderly about the many types of abuse that happens to others just like them on a daily basis.
